

Frequently Asked Questions about NUCS (North Utah County Soccer) “Challenger” (Recreation) Soccer June 2010

Q. How do I register my child for soccer?

A. Assuming you mean “Challenger” (Recreations) soccer, registration is closed. However, you may put your child's name on a waiting list for the coming Fall 2010 season. It is located on the main page of the league website. <http://northutahcountysoccer.com>.. If you are not able to get on a team in the fall, there is also a spring registration that will allow you to join.

Q. Is my kid old enough to play? Too old to play?

A. S/he must be at least 4 years old and not yet 17 years old on August 1st of this year. Consult the age group chart at the end to see in what group your child would play.

Q. My kid wants to play with his friends Bob and Dave, and/or be on Coach Smith's team. How do I make that happen?

A. Although, there's a place on the registration form to write in ONE request of this kind, at this point as a late registration. It is very unlikely that you will be placed on a team of your choosing.

Q. My kid is big (or small) for his age - can they play up (or down) a year?

A. S/he can play up one year; nobody plays down.

Q. Can I sign up for Fall only or Spring only?

A. Your registration fee covers Fall and Spring together. If you bail out after Fall, we don't issue a refund. If you want to play in Spring only, we have a limited registration in January, but team placement is on a space-available basis.

Q. What is the fee?

A. \$85 for Fall 2010 and Spring 2011: this covers registration, a regulation soccer ball, and a full uniform (shirt, shorts, socks) in team colors. This includes a \$15.00 late fee

Q. Do I sign up my kid again next Spring?

A. Please don't re-register your kid next Spring – it will just confuse us, and we are easily confused.

Q. When are games played?

A. Mostly Saturdays, some Thursdays, from late August to mid-October and then from early April to mid-May.

Q. When and where are the practices?

A. Whenever and wherever the coach says they are. We don't schedule practice times and fields as a league; it's up to each coach. We ask each coach to have at least one practice a week.

Q. I have more questions. How can I contact you guys?

A. Please do NOT consult the nice people at the local city offices. They are kind enough to let us use their facilities for registration, but do not get paid to be our PR staff. Instead, please go to our web site www.nucsonline.com, read the material there, and if necessary reach out and touch us using the e-mail contact links. Depending on our current workload, we'll get back to you Pretty Darned Soon.

Competition Soccer Information

Q. What is the difference between "Challenger" and "Recreation" and "Competition" and "AA"?

A. They are the different names people use for the two programs NUCS offers. □ "Challenger" = our Recreation program. No tryouts, no win-loss records; intended to introduce youth to the sport and enhance their skills.

□ "Competition (AA)" is a higher level that involves tryouts, win-loss records, tournaments, etc. The open registrations we conduct at the Highland City Building are for Challenger soccer only.

Q. So when are Competition tryouts?

Tryouts for this year have already happened. The next ones will be in approx. May 2011. However, If you would like your child to be considered for a competition team for this year as space permits. Please fill out the AA Competition waiting list located on the website.
